All visitors please don't forget to use the Hand Sanitiser when entering or leaving the building.



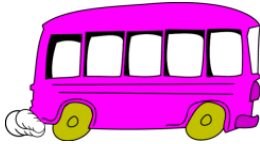
Winter season is approaching and for the Health & Safety of all Residents we encourage everyone to have their flu vaccinations done. Thank You
